ATLANTA – June 18, 2010 – Village Place Brookhaven (www.vpbrookhaven.com) is pleased to announce that popular local chef and Brookhaven resident Joey Riley will open Kaleidoscope Bistro & Pub early this fall.

“I have been living in Brookhaven for more than a decade and while passing Village Place Brookhaven on my way to work, it became obvious that this mixed-use development would be the perfect spot for me to open my own restaurant,” says Joey Riley, who for the past six years has been the executive chef of Buckhead Life Restaurant Group’s Buckhead Diner.

Riley and his business partner Doug Gross, who also lives within walking distance of Village Place Brookhaven, intend to bring a true neighborhood restaurant and pub to Brookhaven, “...one that we can all call home. We promise to give the neighborhood great food at an affordable price, new opportunities to make and meet friends and a warm atmosphere – while still offering a distinct, chef-driven concept. Kaleidoscope at Village Place Brookhaven will be perfect for family dinners, first dates and significant anniversaries” notes Riley.

Riley was born in Florida, went to the Culinary Institute of America in New York and spent time in Thailand. Since coming to Atlanta in 1989, he has worked as chef in nearly a dozen restaurants in Atlanta including TomTom, Goldfish and Nan’s Thai Fine Dining. Kaleidoscope’s menu will offer something for everyone based on fresh and local ingredients, combining the best of various cuisines worldwide. Its wine and beer program will feature approachable, affordable selections, highlighting smaller vineyards and independent breweries.

“Kaleidoscope Bistro & Pub at Village Place Brookhaven will not only be an asset for the development, but for the entire community,” says Dillon Baynes, president of Orinda Corporation, who manages Village Place Brookhaven on behalf of Wrightwood Capital.

“We are pleased that Chef Riley has selected Village Place Brookhaven as the place to open his first own restaurant,” notes Baynes. “This new bistro/pub adds to the variety of restaurants in the Brookhaven area, making our part of Atlanta even more of a destination for dining out.”

Located in Atlanta’s fashionable Brookhaven community on Dresden Drive within walking distance (less than a quarter mile) from the Brookhaven/Oglethorpe MARTA station, Village Place Brookhaven features 41 luxury residences and 11 office condominiums, built above retail and restaurant space in two buildings. The live-work community is nestled in a 5-acre park-like setting not far from Peachtree Road. The development is close to some of the city’s most popular restaurants and cafes and is just five minutes from Lenox Square, Phipps Plaza and the Buckhead business district.
